Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on July 1, 2013 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

Public Comment: A public hearing was held for the purpose of public input for distribution of the 2013-2014 Human Service Development Funds (HSDF). Requests for funding were received from Perry Human Services, MH.IDD, and the Perry County Food Bank.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the minutes of June 24, 2013. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried. Commissioner Naylor Abstained, he was not present at the meeting.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the warrant list for the week of July 1, 2013, in the amount of \$87,172.28. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of the Cumberland Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the following agreement:

- ***Eagleville Hospital*** detox renewal effective 7/1/13 thru 6/30/14

Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the Administrative Agreement between the Cumberland County Housing Authority and Perry County. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried. This is the annual agreement for the Authority to administer the Rental Assistance Housing Choice Voucher Program for Perry County for 129 vouchers.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to set the salaries for elected officials effective January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2019 at an increase of 2.5% per year with the exception of the Auditors, which is a base salary of \$139.27 per day. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried. Commissioner Naylor asked that the minutes reflect that this is a second income for them; but for other elected officials this is their only income. The last pay raise the commissioners paid back their 3% increase along with the Register/Recorder. Union employees will be receiving a 3.5% increase and feels we have to compensate our elected officials fairly. Commissioner Benner opposed. Commissioner Benner feels elected officials know what their salary is before coming into office and feels our elderly population is having a difficult time making ends meet and we should look out for the people in the county.
