Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on July 16, 2012 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

Public Comments: Malinda Anderson and Dale Beaston informed the Board that the Boro has 2 town marker signs that are now antiques in their building that have been recently repaired and restored to their original state. Discussion was made as to the placement of these markers somewhere in the Boro.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the minutes of July 9, 2012. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to sign the application for the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency for the Perry County Intermediate Punishment Program in the amount of \$50,000.

Based on the recommendation of the Cumberland-Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to appoint Andrew Blasco to fill a vacant slot on the Drug & Alcohol Commission Community Advisory Board for a three year term from June 2012 through June 2015. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendations to the changes by the Solicitor, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the contract with Mid Atlantic Monitoring Services, LLC for SCRAM (Secure Continuous Remote Alcohol Monitors) for ankle bracelet straps for the Perry County Adult Probation Office at a rate of \$3.25 for Standard radio frequency, \$4.75 per day for Cellular radio frequency and \$6.75 per day for active GPS, equipment lease, and monitoring.

Employee Status: Based on the recommendation of Gary Eby, PCTA Director, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve Glenn Brauchi as a part time driver at the rate of \$9.34 hour, effective July 23, 2012. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of Michele Harris, Aging Director, Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the hiring of Carol Harter as an Aging Care Manager in the Office of Aging at the rate of \$15.23 per hour, effective July 30, 2012. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of Chad Chenot, D.A., Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the hiring of Salena Haas, clerk, in the D.A.'s office, \$10.53 per hour, effective July 23, 2012. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of Tom Radel, Probation Director, Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the hiring of Michael Steadele as an Adult/Juvenile probation officer, \$15.23 per hour, effective July 23, 2012. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Solicitors Report: Solicitor Bunt gave an update on union negotiations involving Courthouse and residual employees' that should be presented the middle or end of August depending on the Union.

A lawsuit was filed against the Perry County Transportation Authority involving a Mr. Larry Walters. CCAP insurance has been notified.
