Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on July 30, 2012 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence. Solicitor Bunt was absent.

Public Comments: Ben Laudermilch, Executive Director, Cumberland County Redevelopment Authority asked the board to approve budget revisions to the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program to increase funding in the amount of \$1,784.92 to assist Homeless Prevention Consumers for Cumberland County. Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve this revision. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the minutes of July 23, 2012, with an amendment to the minutes removing the wording conditional on the approval of the solicitor from the bid that was awarded to Tom Lowe and C. Richard Beers. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to sign the warrant list in the amount of \$91,244.82 for the week of July 30, 2012. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to sign the agreement between the County and Evaluator Services and Technology, Inc. regarding the use of Randy Waggoner, CPE and Donna Buckley, CPE for informal reviews and/or formal appeals conducted as part of the Lebanon County Reassessment project. Lebanon County will reimburse Perry County for the cost of salaries and mileage.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to sign the agreement between the County and Perry County Veterans Transportation as a shared-ride provider on behalf of the County and DPW. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the Medical Assistance Transportation Program fourth quarter report for the Perry County Transportation Authority for reimbursement for transportation or mileage reimbursement for clients for medical access for trips to medical appointments that are paid for by medical assistance. A total of \$366,500 was spent to provide transportation and \$37,624 was reimbursed to clients during the 2011-2012 fiscal year.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to sign the Preventative Maintenance Agreement with CILS Incorporated for preventative maintenance of the 2 commercial washers and the 2 commercial dryers at the Perry County Prison at a cost of \$315.00 per visit, two times a year. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to rescind the motion to award the paving contract that was approved at the Commissioners meeting on July 23, 2012 to Kitner Bros. for a cost of \$16,360. It was discovered that there was a second bid given to the County regarding this project. This bid will be advertised and awarded at a future meeting. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.
