Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on June 20, 2011 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to sign the warrant list in the amount of \$390,530.91 for the week of May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Commissioner Amsler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to award the fuel and propane bids to the low bidder Swenson Fuels, Inc. based on the market price plus \$.15 per gallon deliver. Commissioner Amsler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of the Mental Health/I.D.D. Board, and Sue Carbaugh, Commissioner Amsler made a motion to approve the Contract Addendum for the Pennsylvania's Consolidated and Support Waiver to provide services to persons eligible to receive waiver services. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of Will Cameron, Resolution 2011-9 was adopted for the execution of the NBIS Inspection to P.D.O.T. for the Agreement between the County and Pennoni Associates, Inc., which provides for the inspection and inventory of bridges in Perry County. This agreement covers 43 locally owned bridges; twelve belong to the county and 31 belong to the townships and boroughs. Effective from 2011-2016.

Adam Lewesky presented plans to the board for the Business Campus Way widening and intersection project.
