Public Comments: None.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the minutes of May 21, 2012. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to sign the warrant list in the amount of \$464,957.22 for the week of May 29, 2012 and June 4, 2012. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of Jeannine Matulevich, Perry Housing Partnership, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the Administrative Agreement between the County, Perry Housing Partnership, and the Redevelopment Authority of Cumberland County in the amount of \$53,000 to enter into a HOME grant contract with DCED for Community Housing Development operating expenses. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to renew the agreement with Tom Stephenson Generator Service, Inc. for the emergency generators for 911. This Agreement is for one year in the amount of \$2,970.00. This agreement covers the CAT unit located at 911, New Bloomfield site, and the Buffalo site. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.
