Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on May 19, 2014 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence. The meeting was held in the law library at the courthouse.

**Public Comment:** None.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the minutes of May 12, 2014. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried. Commissioner Naylor opposed because it did not follow Roberts Rule of Order. Commissioner Naylor quoted Robert's Rule; "minutes should include names of guest and their subject matter" also "What to leave out, The minutes are a factual record of business. Do not include Opinions or judgments. Leave out statements like a Well Done report or heated discussion", "Criticism or accolades, Criticism of members, good or bad should not be included"

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the warrant list in the amount of \$226,804.05. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried. Commissioner Naylor noted that an invoice for \$457.49 for weed kill for the prison has been directed to maintenance because of the high cost.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to table the recommendation letter for Perry County Bridge 13 (Bixler Run Bridge) until more information could be obtained. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried. The letter requested that HATS (Harrisburg Area Transportation Study) add the replacement of Perry County Bridge no. 13 to the Transportation Improvement Program for the amount of \$1,710,000.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the request of a time extension until May 23, 2014 to Jay Fulkroad & Sons, Inc., regarding completion of the remaining punch list items for the Perry County, SR 0274 Section 017 Roadway Widening and Signal Installation for the Business Campus Way. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of the Cumberland-Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the following agreements for inpatient non-hospital fee-for-service drug and alcohol treatment providers effective July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to accept the letter of retirement for Susan Dunkleberger, deputy treasurer, effective June 3, 2014. Commissioner Rudy expressed his gratitude for Sue's 23 years of service to the County. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made the motion to hire Matthew O'Toole as a p/t driver-detailer for P.C.T.A., effective Tuesday, May 20, 2014. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made the motion to appoint Kristine Adkins to First Deputy Treasurer, effective Monday, May 19, 2014. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**Solicitors Report-** Nothing that required Action. Solicitor Bunt informed the Board that an Appeal has been filed by the Office of Open Records regarding a request by Joshua Prince, Prince Law Firm because an Open Records Request to the County that was not answered within the 5 day period. Mr. Prince then filed another right to know request and received a response for his first request and a 30 day time extension on his second request regarding the Perry County Auditors and Sheriff's Department. Mr. Prince has since dropped his appeal with the Office of Open Records.

**Public Comments:** Comments from the public were made regarding auditing of the Sheriffs Permits to carry firearms.

Jim Lucas presented the board with a copy of a letter regarding the Perry County Auditors illegal demand for the license to carry firearms list. The sheriff, district attorney, solicitor, and the Perry County Times received a copy of the letter.

Larry Reisinger noted that this cost of a solicitor for the auditors will only add to the 2014 proposed budget showing the county is running in a deficit.

Commissioner Naylor once again stated that he is a neutral party and would like the question of the auditors being considered the public be addressed.

Commissioner Rudy stated that his stand is that the audit has been completed and seeing the actual names of permits should not be an issue. Commissioner Rudy also thanked the public for taking their time to attend the Monday meetings and voicing their concerns.

On another note Dr. Pat Gutheil asked if Black Fly spraying will be done in the County this year. The answer was they started spraying last Thursday along the rivers.

**Open Forum for the Press:** Sean asked for a copy of the letter regarding the Bixler Run Bridge transportation improvement program for H.A.T.S.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to adjourn at 10:45 a.m. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.
