Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on October 15, 2012 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

**Public Comments:** None.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the minutes of October 8, 2012. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to sign the warrant list in the amount of \$148,871.14. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of the Cumberland-Perry Drug & Alcohol Commission, Commissioner Rudy made a motion to amend the Perry Human Services Prevention Agreement to increase the amount to be reimbursed from \$85,122 to \$106,190 for the period beginning July 1, 2012 and ending June 30, 2013. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.
