Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on October 31, 2011 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

Public Comments: None.

Commissioner Amsler made a motion to approve the minutes of October 24, 2011. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to sign the warrant list in the amount of \$48,976.52 for the week of October 31, 2011. Commissioner Amsler seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Amsler made a motion to certify that the county has reserved funds in the amount of \$2,145.00 to be used for the purchase of an Agricultural Conservation Easement on the 291 acre Edward C. and Melinda Martin farm in South West Madison Township. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of nominating organizations, Commissioner Amsler made a motion to reappoint Melvin Weaver, District Farmer Director and David Shenk, III, District Public Director to serve a four term on the Soil District Conservation Board. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Amsler made a motion to appoint Commissioner Stephen Naylor to serve a one year term on the Soil District Conservation Board. Commissioner Benner seconded the motion. Motion carried. This term will expire January 1, 2013.

A grant in the amount of \$5,000 was received by the County from the Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program. An advertisement was placed in the newspapers and one request for the grant was received. After discussion, the Board unanimously agreed to recommend to the food bank advisory board that the grant be awarded to the Perry County Food Bank.

Solicitors Report:

An upset tax sale was held in the commissioner's conference room this morning and no properties were sold at this time. Margaret Bolton informed the board that she is requesting advanced authorization from the Board to offer the sale of four mobile home properties that are in Repository Sale. Commissioner Amsler made a motion authorize this request along with the approval of the township and school district. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.
