Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on September 14, 2015 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

Public Comment: Questions were asked and answered by the public.

Approval of Minutes: Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the minutes of September 14, 2015. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Approval of Warrant List: Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the warrant list for a total of \$149,894.66 for the week of September 21, 2015. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

A Proclamation was presented to the Lions Club to help raise awareness of the meaning of the white cane and of the need to exercise special care for the blind person who carries it. On Wednesday, October 15, the Lions Club has designated the date of October 15 as ***“National White Cane Safety Day”***.

A Proclamation was presented to the Lions Club to help raise awareness to November 14th as ***“World Diabetes Day”***. 387 million adults have been living with diabetes in 2014 and the estimated cost for diabetes management is \$610 billion dollars internationally. Elizabeth Moffatt asked if the commissioners would place blue lights in their windows to serve as a reminder of the global impact of diabetes.
