Commissioner Benner opened the meeting at 10:00 AM on September 29, 2014 with the Pledge to the Flag and a moment of silence.

Public Comment: Jack Carroll, Cumberland/Perry Drug Alcohol Director attended the meeting to ask for letters of support in contacting their legislators and ask for a comprehensive approach to Pennsylvania's substance abuse and drug overdose epidemic. The two critical issues that need attention are establishing a drug monitoring system and providing increased access to naloxone, which is a rescue drug that reverses the effects of opiates and is effective in treating overdoses.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the minutes of September 22, 2014. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the warrant list for a total of \$317,152.40 for the week of September 29, 2014. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Naylor made a motion to table the PrimeCare Medical Contract with the Prison until a meeting is held with the warden and business manager. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Based on the recommendation of the Mh/IDD board, Commissioner Naylor made a motion to approve the contract with Diakon Child, Family and Community Ministries in the amount of \$72,500. This is a renewal contract for outpatient Mental Health Services. Commissioner Rudy seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Rudy made a motion to approve the proposal for forensic autopsy services and associated fees for 2015 with Forensic Pathology Associates (FPA) Health Network Laboratories, effective January 1, 2015 in the amount of \$1390 for routine Forensic Autopsy Services and \$625 for Neuropathology Consultative Services through December 31, 2015. Commissioner Naylor seconded the motion. Motion carried.
