## SUPPORTIVE SERVICES FOR VETERAN FAMILIES

### ELIGIBILITY

To receive supportive services from the program, you must be:

- **A member of a veteran family.** A veteran family defined as a single person or family in which the head of household or the spouse of the head of household is a veteran.
- **Classified as very low-income.** Your household income cannot exceed 50 percent of the area median income where you live.
- **Homeless or at immediate risk of homelessness.** You must be in permanent housing, scheduled to move into housing within 90 days, or have exited permanent housing within the last 90 days.

### ASSESSMENT

For a full case assessment, contact us to obtain an application and to schedule an appointment.

Once you have a scheduled appointment, bring the following documents with you:

- A photo I.D.
- A copy of your DD-214 that shows your discharge type/status or a VA medical card
- Proof of income
- Social Security cards for all family members to be served
- Birth certificates for any dependent children to be served
- Any lease/rental statements, past due notices, and utility bills if seeking financial assistance
