## Why Recycle?\*

Recycling creates 1.1 million U.S. jobs, \$236 billion in gross annual sales and \$37 billion in annual payrolls.

Recycling prevents habitat destruction, loss of biodiversity, and soil erosion associated with logging and mining.

A national recycling rate of 30% reduces greenhouse gas emissions as much as removing nearly 25 million cars from the road.

It takes 95% less energy to recycle aluminum than it does to make it from raw materials. Making recycled steel saves 60%, recycled newspaper 40%, recycled plastics 70%, and recycled glass 40%. These savings far outweigh the energy created as by-products of incineration and land filling.



Recycling these items is a great way to participate in protecting our environment. The Perry Conservation District, Keep Perry County Beautiful, and the State Department of Environmental Protection are pleased to be able to provide this recycling opportunity for you.

## Benefits of e-cycling

- Keeps hazardous substances such as lead and mercury out of the environment.
- Cuts down on the need to purchase or mine for new raw materials by reusing valuable materials from old computers.
- Helps others to access electronics they may not be able to afford otherwise.
- Creates jobs for those who recycle and refurbish electronic goods.
- 95% of materials are recycled in the United States.
