**SR 274 SECTION 017 ROADWAY WIDENING AND SIGNAL INSTALLATION  
PERRY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

Sealed proposals will be received by The Commissioners of Perry County at the office of the Commissioners, Veterans Memorial Building, 25 West Main Street, P.O. Box 37, New Bloomfield, PA 17068, until 10:15 o'clock AM, prevailing time, on November 19, 2012 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read for the construction of SR 274, Section 017 roadway widening and signal installation.

The bids must cover all costs for the completion of this project as set forth in the Contract Documents. The principle items of work to be performed under the contract are: (1) widening and overlay of SR 274 to allow for the construction of a westbound left turn lane and an eastbound right turn lane, (2) drainage improvements, (3) installation of a new traffic signal, (4) installation and removal of erosion and sediment pollution control devices and (5) maintenance and protection of traffic.

Plans and specifications are on file and open to public inspection at the office of the Owner, Veterans Memorial Building, New Bloomfield, and the office of the Consulting Engineer. Copies may be procured by prospective bidders by applying to the office of the Owner, 25 West Main Street, P.O. Box 37, New Bloomfield, PA 17068 or the office of the Engineer. The non-refundable cost of reproduction and handling will be \$25.00 per set. Mail requests will be an additional \$10.00. All checks will be made payable to the County of Perry.

This project is subject to the Prevailing Wage Act requirements. Bidders must be PennDOT prequalified as specified in Section 102.01 and Section 102.06 (c) of Publication 408. Contractors qualifying as subcontractors may submit bids as a prime contractor, consistent with their qualifications.

The County of Perry in accordance with Title VI of the U.S. Civil Rights Act of 1964 and Parts 21 and 23 of 49 C.F.R., notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that DBE will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and that no person will be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin in consideration for an award. A DBE Goal of 6% is required for this project.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the County of Perry in an amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid or bids. Only bonds from companies licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will be accepted and the bond will so state same.

Bids must be submitted unconditionally. No bidder may withdraw bid within ninety (90) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

The County of Perry reserves the right to waive any informality, or to reject any or all bids.
