

## Register for South Central Alerts

Help protect yourself, your friends, and your family by registering today! It's free and it only takes a few minutes.

Register online at [www.sctfpa.org](http://www.sctfpa.org). Click on the South Central Alert logo on the left-hand side of the homepage.

Easy directions will help you to:

- 1) Select the type of alerts you'd like to receive
- 2) Enter one or more location(s)
- 3) Select the ways you'd like to be alerted (such as text, e-mail or cell phone) and set the order of priority for each

Registering online is the quickest and easiest method. However, you may also complete a paper registration form which is available from your county emergency management office.

**Note:** All registration information is maintained on a secure server and will NOT be distributed or disseminated to ANY individual or other organization!




### What is South Central Alert?

South Central Alert is a **free** emergency notification system that will notify you of emergency incidents or imminent threats to your health and safety (such as severe weather, evacuations, missing persons, boil water advisories, natural gas leaks, wildfires, road closures, etc.) and other important alerts and community information.

### How Does the South Central Alert System Work?

South Central Alert sends a message to residents within the area of concern. If you register, you will be notified by the phone, text and/or e-mail you requested. Residents who do not register will be notified via traditional landline home or business phone, if it was listed in the White or Yellow Pages.



### How is South Central Alert Different from Other Alert Systems?

South Central Alert allows you to register up to five (5) locations in this region that are important to you (such as home, school, work, church, etc.). You may also select and prioritize the methods used to contact you (such as cell phone, home phone, e-mail, text message, TTD/TTY, etc.), and the type of alerts you receive.

Unlike mass media alerts on TV or radio, South Central Alert will quickly notify you of emergency situations and provide critical information by sending an alert to the phone or e-mail of your choice, no matter where you are.

### What Counties are Covered by South Central Alert?

South Central Alert provides emergency notification to residents and businesses within the following eight (8) counties in the South Central portion of Pennsylvania: Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lancaster, Lebanon, Perry and York.

### What is the South Central Task Force?

The SCTF is an emergency preparedness task force that collaborates and coordinates both public and private sector resources for regional solutions that provide support to communities when events exceed their capabilities.
