

**MAINTENANCE REPAIRS  
OF  
ELEVEN COUNTY BRIDGES  
PERRY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

Sealed bids will be received by The Commissioners of Perry County at the office of the Commissioners, Veterans Memorial Building, 25 West Main Street, P.O. Box 37, New Bloomfield, PA 17068, until 10:15 o'clock AM, prevailing time, on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2016, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read for the construction of Maintenance Repairs of Eleven County Bridges.

The bids must cover all costs for the completion of this project as set forth in the Contract Documents. The principle items of work to be performed under the contract are: (1) sign installation and repair; (2) bridge cleaning and debris removal; (3) joint sealing; (4) guide rail repair; (5) miscellaneous superstructure repair; (6) covered timber bridge repair; (7) stone masonry substructure repointing; and (8) concrete deck repair.

Plans and specifications are on file and open to public inspection at the offices of the Owner and the Consulting Engineer. Copies may be procured by prospective bidders by applying to the office of the Commissioners or the office of the Engineer. The non-refundable cost of reproduction and handling will be \$25.00 per set. Mail requests will be an additional \$10.00. All checks will be made payable to the County of Perry.

This project is estimated to be less than \$100,000 and prevailing wage rates will not apply.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the County of Perry in an amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid or bids. Only bonds from companies licensed to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will be accepted and the bond will so state same.

Bids must be submitted unconditionally. No bidder may withdraw bid within Sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

The County of Perry reserves the right to waive any informality, or to reject any or all bids.
